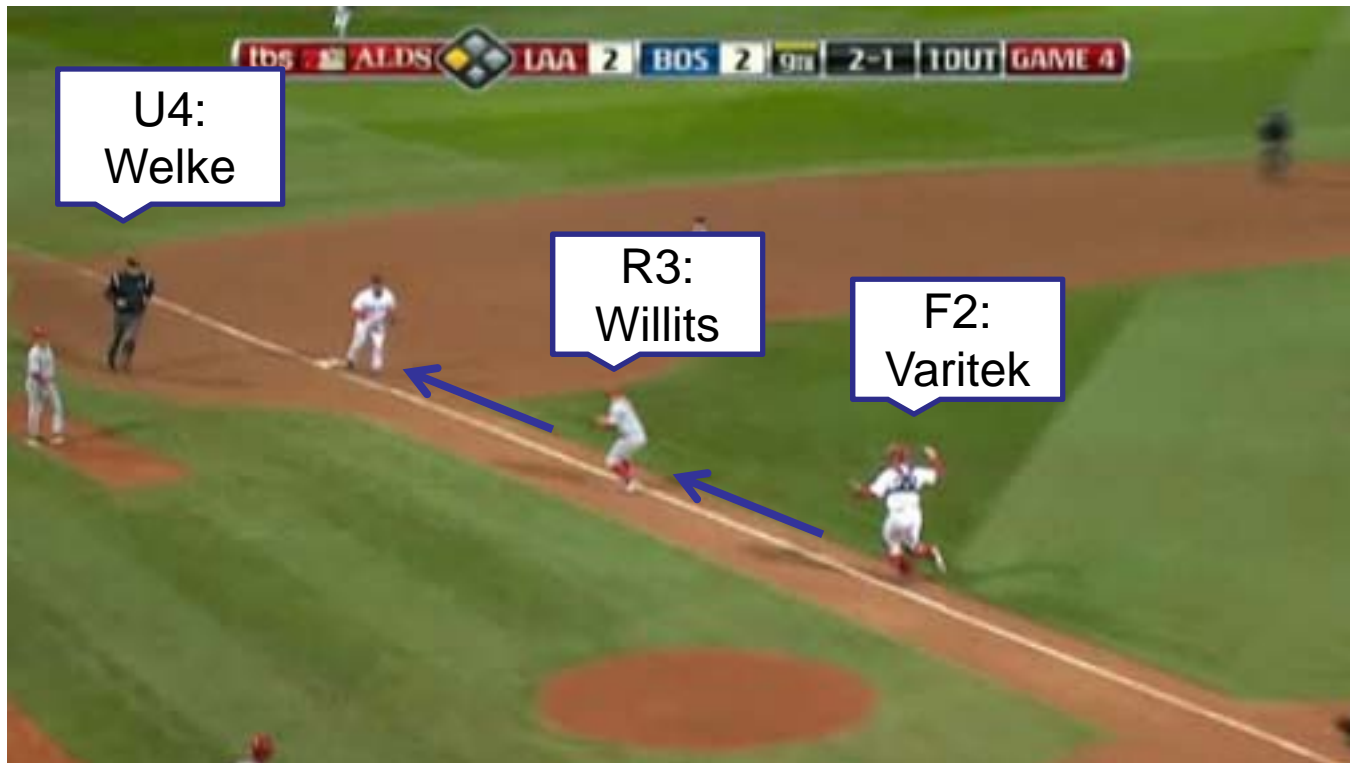

OBR 2.00 – Tag

- ➔ A TAG is the action of a fielder
 - ➔ in touching a base with his body while holding the ball **securely** and **firmly** in his hand or glove;
 - ➔ or touching a runner with the ball, or with his hand or glove holding the ball, while holding the ball **securely** and **firmly** in his hand or glove.
- ➔ It is not a tag, however, if **simultaneously** or **immediately** following his touching a base or touching a runner, the fielder **drops the ball**.
- ➔ In establishing the validity of the tag, the fielder shall **hold the ball long enough to prove that he has complete control** of the ball.
- ➔ If the fielder has made a tag and drops the ball while **in the act of making a throw** following the tag, the tag shall be adjudged to have been made.

OBR 2.00 – Catch

- ➔ A CATCH is the act of a fielder in getting **secure possession** in his hand or glove of a ball in flight and **firmly holding** it [...]
- ➔ It is not a catch, however, if **simultaneously** or **immediately** following his contact with the ball
 - ➔ **he collides with a player, or with a wall, or if he falls down, and as a result of such collision or falling, drops the ball.**
- ➔ In establishing the validity of the catch, the fielder shall **hold the ball long enough to prove that he has complete control** of the ball and that his **release of the ball is voluntary and intentional**.
- ➔ If the fielder has made the catch and **drops the ball while in the act of making a throw** following the catch, the ball shall be adjudged to have been caught.

- Tag Play vs. Catch – tatsächlich gleiches Konzept?
 - Voluntary Release fehlt beim Tag Play
 - Kollisionen und Stürze werden beim Tag Play nicht beschrieben.

- Kraft eines Tag
 - Ballverlust während des Tag Play: Keine Kontrolle, nicht sicher gehalten.
 - Ballverlust nach dem Tag Play: gültiges Play, solange der Ball während des Tag Plays selber sicher gehalten wurde und nicht die Kraft des Tag Plays zum Ballverlust führte.

- Führt die **Kraft des Tags** zum Ballverlust, gilt der Tag nicht. Führt eine andere Kraft zum Ballverlust, gilt der Tag.

- Schwierige Ermessensentscheidung (Judgement)
- Knackpunkt ist nicht so sehr „ **simultaneously**“
 - sondern „**immediately following his contact with the ball**“
- Beispiel
 - Tag Play aus vollem Lauf (erfolgreich), beim Weiterlaufen dann stolpern, schließlich stürzen, Ball verlieren.
